“Special Star Showcase”

“Special Star Showcase” is an animal show at the Marquette County Fair, designed for students with special needs attending school in grades 6-12 in Marquette County.

The “Stars” will be paired up with a livestock exhibitor in 4-H or FFA. In the show ring, the students will be able to show either a chicken, goat, sheep, rabbit, pig or dairy calf. All animals will be provided by the livestock youth and will assist the “Stars” in the show ring. No experience is necessary.

The show will take place on Saturday, July 18 at 9:00 AM. It will be held during the Marquette County Fair. Students are asked to check-in beginning at 8:45 AM in the show barn. At the end of the show, we will take a group photo and participants will receive a gift bag.

To participate, simply complete the attached entry form and return it to the address at the top of the form or email it. The entry form is due back on or before June 19, 2026. Once received, Sheena Wolsdorf will reach out to you.

Why a show like this? We have seen shows like this at other county fairs. I also work with middle/high school special education students and want them to have some of the same experiences as peers. We thought it would be a wonderful opportunity to start one at our fair.

Please note that there are a variety of activities, lights, sounds, etc at the Marquette County Fair both in the show barn and grounds. Parents/guardians should be in the stands in the event that your child needs assistance, but will not be allowed in the show ring unless required by staff.
